

Offshore Technology Days 2012 - Terms and conditions

- 1.** This registration is binding once it has been received by Offshore Media Group AS in completed form.
- 2.** The exhibitor is liable for the total cost connected to the stand, the registration fee and any other costs associated with additional products that are ordered in this document. The responsibility will not be withdrawn by cancellation of the order.
- 3.** An inability to meet the exhibitor's desires for a certain placement of the stand and so on does not give the right to cancel the order, require a price discount, claim compensation or the like.
- 4.** Offshore Media Group makes the final decision to award stands, and reserves the right to reject any application at its discretion.
- 5.** Each exhibitor is bound by all terms and conditions specified in this document. This applies regardless of whether the exhibitor has expressed reservation of any kind, unless the relevant reservation has been accepted in writing by Offshore Media Group.
- 6.** Unless otherwise is agreed in writing and approved by the Offshore Media Group the stand and registration fee must be paid by the due date, the time period for the invoice is described in this document. Documentation that the stand and registration fee has been paid must be available for inspection in order to secure access to the exhibition area.
- 7.** Invoice for 50% of the stands cost and the registration fee will be sent in January 2012, this is sent to all the companies that have received confirmation of the stand location. After January 2012 50% of the stands fee and the registration fee will be charged immediately to all new companies as soon as they receive a specific stand location. On the 1st of July 2012 all companies that participate in next year's Offshore Technology Days will get an invoice for the remaining 50% of the stand fee and the registration fee. The payment deadline on both invoices is 10 days.
- 8.** Failure to comply with payment terms can lead to loss of the assigned stand. The company will still be responsible for costs associated with the order, but the Offshore Media Group has the right to dispose of the stand space leased during the exhibition.
- 9.** It is not allowed to sub-let your company's stand location, or part of the stand location, to other companies. Only companies that are registered can participate, and documentation that the stand and registration fee is paid must be available for inspection in order to secure access to the exhibition area.
- 10.** Technical documentation for the construction of the stand and ordering of additional equipment will be sent by e-mail to all exhibitors well in advance of the start of the exhibition.
- 11.** Offshore Media Group takes no responsibility for any errors by publishing a printed or electronic information concerning Offshore Technology Days.
- 12.** Offshore Media Group AS reserves the right to cancel the exhibition if substantive grounds exist. In the event of a cancellation any stand and registration fee paid will be refunded.
- 13.** Exhibitors must comply with Norwegian law and the statutory regulations, and acquire any and all permits required in connection with the exhibition from the responsible authorities.
